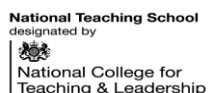

Return to School: 2nd September 2020

Dear Parents/Carers

School will commence for all pupils in all year groups on Wednesday 2nd September. Arrangements for children's health and safety will be similar to those that were in place prior to the summer holidays :

- Children will enter school through their usual doors (signposted) from 8.40 – 9.00am.
- Children will be dismissed through the same doors from 3.15pm – staggered exit by classes.
- Breakfast club will operate from 7.40-8.40am for working parents only – please only use this if absolutely necessary.
- After school clubs will operate from 3.15 – 4.15pm for limited numbers.
- Kids club will operate from 3.15 – 6.00pm for working parents only – please only use this if absolutely necessary.
- Playtimes and lunchtimes will be staggered and demarcated areas have been allocated to each year group.
- Increased hand washing and cleaning routines throughout the day will be emphasised and supervised, with a number of handwashing stations staggered around the school site.
- All children will have individual stationary equipment.
- Children will stay in class bubbles initially when indoors, extending to year group bubbles towards the end of half term if there are no incidences of Covid 19.
- Outside, children will be allowed to circulate in year group bubbles.
- There will be no assemblies and initially no singing practices – either in classes, year groups or whole school.
- Parents will not be allowed to access the school building unless by prior arrangement.
- Parents should drop off and collect children from their entrance/exit doors whilst adhering to social distancing.

In the event of a Covid outbreak, Public Health England will be informed and advice taken.
